






















Goals And Focus Areas Of The Presidency

The aim of the **presidency in 2023** is to focus the network's activities on the changes and challenges associated with the **current energy crisis** under the **theme** of "**Crisis and Transformation**".

Under this theme, **three thematic dialog events** are planned on pressing energy policy issues of the current energy crisis.

- provide a framework for an exchange of experiences between the energy agencies and external stakeholders
- offer the opportunity to develop coordinated proposals for solutions

WS1: Strengthening the value chains of the energy transition in Europe (STIPE)

WS2: Energy Efficiency in the Building Sector (MEPS & Energiesprong)

WS3: RED II and national instruments for the heat transition (REDI4Heat)



Workshop 1: Strengthening The Value Chains Of The Energy Transition In Europe (STIPE)

Ensure availability of essential energy transition technologies and increase resilience of value chains to future crises.

- Ensuring demand for European technology
- Safeguarding the critical input variables capital, skilled labor, raw materials, energy

Goals:

- Identify challenges in making critical energy transition technologies available.
- Derive policy recommendations
- Workshop Format: hybrid event in Berlin, in May, half-day workshop



Workshop 2: MEPS & Energiesprong

Workshop idea

Combines political discussion with experiences and best practice.

- Political discussion
 - Focus: minimum energy performance standards (MEPS)
 - Exchange on existing experiences and approaches
 - Challenges and best practice arising from EPBD requiements
- Serial renovation (EnergieSprong)
 - Addresses numerous aspects to scale up refurbishment activities
 - Best practice according to EU-COMM
 - Discussion on existing / planned national activities, role that agencies (can potentially) plan an dfurhter EnR support
- Workshop Format: June as hybrid event (Berlin or Paris) tbc







Workshop 3: Joint Event With Redi4heat

EU-project REDI4Heat

Red Implementation For Heating And Cooling

- Initiated via EnR network
- Project duration: 1.10.2022 30.09.2025





Targets

- Support the implementation of the Renewable Energy Directive provisions on heating and cooling
- Assist Member States and local authorities to comply with referred targets
- Workshop Format: in November as hybrid event, potentially as part of Thinking Group Meeting, potentially in cooperation with another EnR member agency




