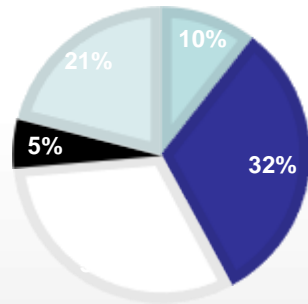
## Public part of the website

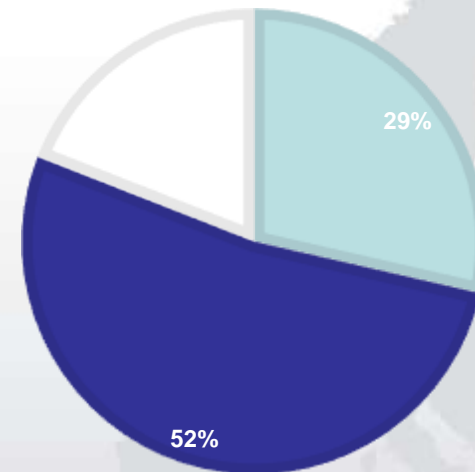

## Recommendations

### Key role of agencies to bridge the gap

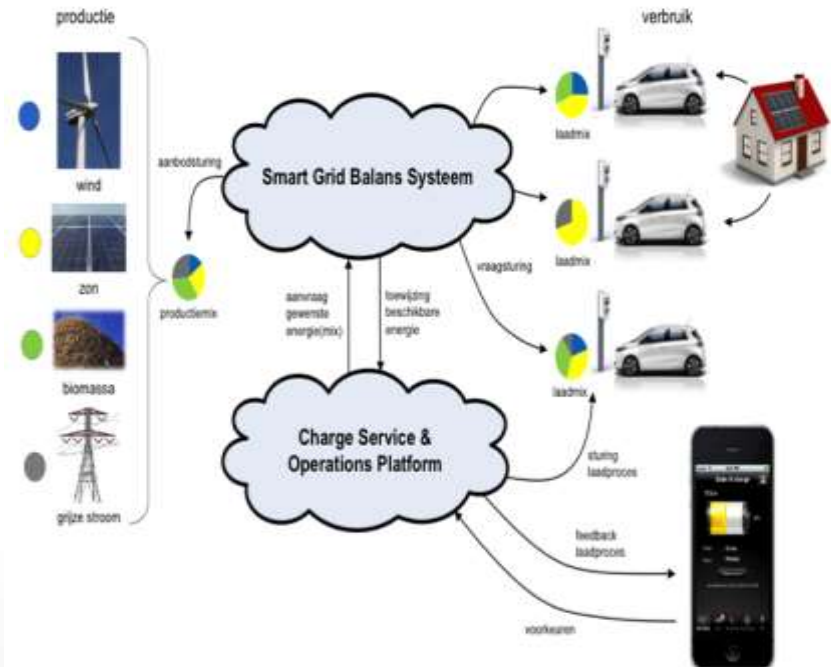
- between individual and collective interests, consequences on how instruments are designed and implemented
