Overview

- Established in 2014 within the Ministry for Energy and Water Management
- Constitutes the policy support arm of the Ministry
- Has grown significantly in terms of resources by the end of 2018, the agency had a workforce of almost 50 professionals (engineers, architects, scientists, and economists)
- The Agency is tasked with ensuring supply-security, use-sustainability and affordability of the energy and water sectors in Malta
- Well-placed to take into account and identify synergies arising from the energywater nexus in the Maltese Islands



Policy-Oriented

- Primary role of the Agency: The development and coordination of the implementation of policies, strategies and action plans
- The implementation of policies is supported through the design and execution of projects related to policy objectives
- The Agency has a wide remit in the energy sector





Policy Design & Implementation

- Leading the development of the National Energy and Climate Plan (2021-2030)
- Renewable Energy Directive & Energy Efficiency Directive
 - Transposition of directives
 - Development and implementation of NREAP and NEEAP
- Development and maintenance of **energy models**
- **Research and Innovation Strategy** for Energy and Water (2021-2030)





Policy Design & Implementation

- Provide the necessary technical input and support to the Ministry:
 - During negotiations on EU legislative proposals covering energy and water sectors
 - Participation in **EU technical working groups**
 - Development of energy markets
 - Ensure government interventions are in line with state-aid regulations
- Stakeholder engagement (organisation of topical conferences, dissemination of best practices etc.)



Project Development & Execution

Identification of & role in key national projects:

- Development of a **gas pipeline** between Malta and Sicily (Project of PCI Status)
- Nation-wide **retrofitting of street lighting** with LED technology
- The National Water Conservation Awareness Centre
- The National Water Awareness Campaign
- Identification and coordination of key national projects such as Net Zero Impact Utility Project





Project Development & Execution

In the residential and domestic sector:

- Communal solar PV farms
- Replacement of inefficient domestic appliances (free of charge) in vulnerable households
- Free service to all households with tailor-made advice on increasing energy and water efficiency and lowering consumption
