## Energy Efficiency First Principle

- Assessment on Decision making \& Planning
- Application to policies \& measures
- Spread to regional, local and private levels


## Proposal for recast of Directive

- More ambitious targets
- Energy Efficiency as the most cost effective solution for energy poverty alleviation
- Proposed extension of ETS to buildings \& Transport revenues - Social Climate fund 'The fund' ${ }^{\prime}>$ mitigate negative results.
- Complementarity of policies
- Strengthening the support of articles 7 (obligation schemes) 5 \& 6 (Public sector
