Work Programme

- Exchange between working group members/discussion and know-how transfer on current policies to strengthen energy efficiency in industry
- Especially: Exchange on EED – Implementation of Article 8 at different member states
- Participation and support of EnR general work programme (i.e. input for consultation papers)
- Ongoing exchange about possible H2020 proposals

Activities 2015 - 2018

- Regular telephone conferences (twice a year)
- WG-I meetings :
 - 12th June 2015 in The Hague (8 participants)
 - 13th September 2016 in Berlin (6 participants)
- Questionnaire and overview – Waste heat usage and support programmes for industry
- Questionnaire and overview– Energy benchmarks for industry
- Working Group contribution to the consultation paper on „Integrated Energy“
- Information-Exchange with STEAM-UP-project
- Exchange on ideas for projects, tenders and H2020 proposals
- Review of TORs (based on input from a detailed Questionnaire)

Evaluation of the WG-I: Status quo

- Review of the WG-I for the years 2015 – 2018: Aims, impact and Work Programme
 - Aim: Objective of WG-I of information exchange fulfilled, objective of initiating projects not fulfilled, objective of providing a forum for communication and cooperation fulfilled
 - Strategic impact: Provide expertise of EnR members to the EC and other institutions fulfilled,
 - Work Programme: Annual agendas were completed (e.g. regular telcos)
- Success of the WG-I: Input for EnR position paper on “mandatory energy audits for non SME” provided.
- Decision to keep the TOR of the WG-I

Evaluation of the WG-I: Future perspectives

- **Self assessment:**
 - *Generally positive feedback from WG-I members, especially on periodical exchange on the state of implementation of Article 8 EED*
 - *Great commitment of members – “It is good to have a network”*
 - *Excellent community for expert opinions*
- **Problems identified:**
 - *Lack of resources (e.g. staff) to participate in meetings/telcos*
 - *Divergent interests of members (e.g. different topics)*
 - *Different motivation of members (e.g. application/funding for joint project calls versus information exchange)*
 - *How to get more members*
- **Plans for future (improvement):**
 - *Change of WG-Chair in February 2018 – if a new WG-Chair will not found the WG-I will be made a sleeping WG, for a while*
 - *More exchange on the update of EED*
