The M71 EnR Regular Meeting will take place in Lisbon on June 7 and 8, 2022, and will be the first opportunity for EnR members to meet in person since 2020.

During this 2-day event, we aim to create a space for open a discussion on the EnR network current and upcoming challenges, and how agencies can leverage their collaboration to better serve their mission.

Finding solutions to climate change is a global effort that begins at the local level. Solving climate change requires action at multiple nested governance levels and involving multiple stakeholders responding to the particularities of the specific countries, regions, cities or communities. Local actors and citizens must also promote and adopt solutions suitable for the economy and the wallet. That's why energy agencies work with decision-makers, from national policymakers to local community leaders, by mobilizing local authorities, economic players and citizens to fight climate change, to pave the way for decarbonizing the European Economy and to foster cities pivotal role for an acceleration of the delivery on the European Green Deal.

This year, ADENE, the Portuguese Energy Agency took over the Presidency of the European Energy Network (EnR), a network that brings together 24 national energy agencies from European countries. Created in 1990, EnR's mission is to promote policies, programs and national or European initiatives in the fields of energy efficiency, renewable energy, and climate change mitigation. In 2022, EnR will focus on five thematic areas: energy poverty, renewable energy communities, water-energy nexus, cooperation and green jobs.

Organized within the Portuguese Presidency of the European Energy Network, this event will bring together national energy agencies, local actors and other stakeholders that, in two participatory roundtables, will discuss strategic responses in the short, medium and long term to the current energy crisis in Europe, the significance of the balance between the three dimensions of the energy trilemma (security, affordability and sustainability), the importance of a radical focus on energy efficiency and decarbonization, and the need for the identification of ways to unlock opportunities for collaborative action between national and local actors.
