- New member: Sonia Munnix, Netherlands Enterprise Agency (RVO)

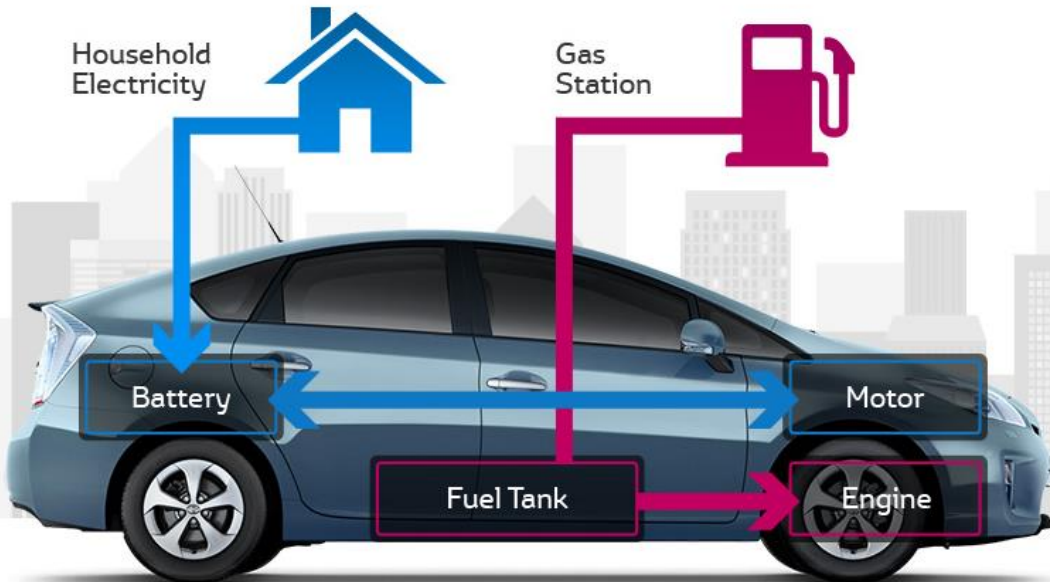
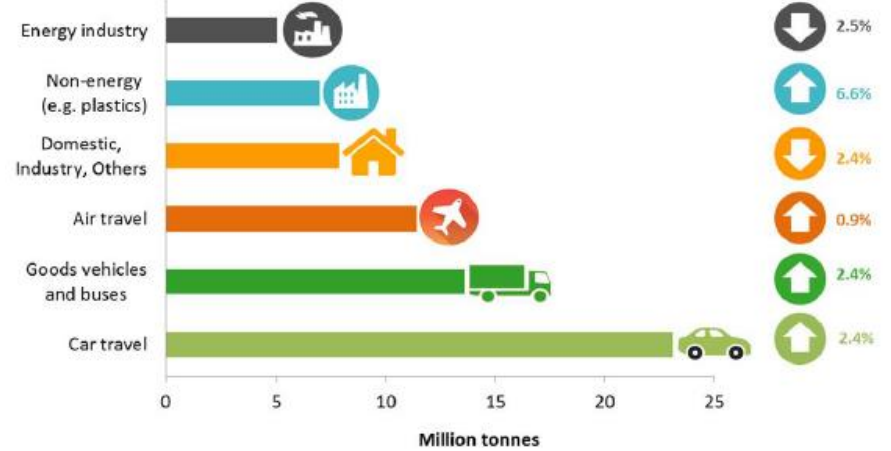
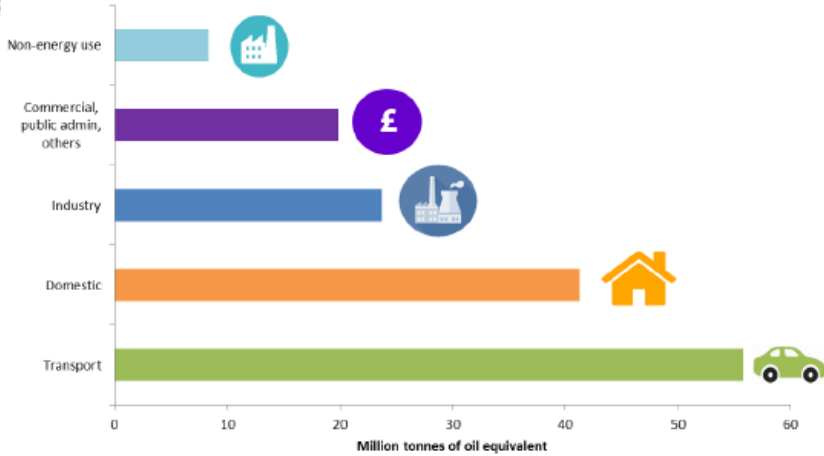
New chair
