Description of Project

OPIC 2014-2020 concentrates resources on Thematic Objective 4. "Supporting the shift towards a low-carbon economy in all sectors" to support the reduction of energy intensity as a priority in the manufacturing industry, respectively – for an increase of energy efficiency in industry and production buildings.

The investments are under Priority Axis 3"Energy and Resource Efficiency" which provides for support for reducing the energy intensity of the economy, primarily through increased energy efficiency and flexibility of the enterprises, and hence of the country's economy in line with the Energy Strategy of Bulgaria till 2020 and National Energy Efficiency Action Plan 2014-2020.

Target group – existing enterprises (except for trade and services sectors).



Aim/Expected Impact of Project

The enterprises are to be supported for measures with energy-saving potential based on the energy audit and thereby their implementation is expected to contribute with more than 7 % to the national objective for additional energy savings set in the Plan and more than 40% of the objective for additional energy savings by the industry.

Procedure "Enhancement of Energy Efficiency in Large Enterprises"

- 68 projects
