Renovation Accelerator

Description of Project

The Renovation Accelerator stimulates large-scale renovation projects of (housing) corporation homes through innovation on both the demand and supply side. A partnership of both these markets can submit a subsidy proposal to receive funds for a collective renovation project. This partnership has to consist of:

- A minimum of 2 home owners who bring in at least 50 properties into the partnership
- At least 150 properties built before 1995, which have to be renovated within 3 years
- Properties that will be renovated towards a maximum heat demand of 70 kWh/m² and a higher subsidy will be granted to a heat demand below 50 kWh/m²
- Enterprises carrying out the renovation project with at least one SME participating

There is a total of € 100 million available, spread over the course of four years, starting November 2020.

Aim/Expected Impact of Project

The goal of this subsidy programme is to create more cooperation among suppliers, and to deliver on an integral, standardised and industrialised supply of renovation schemes. The knowledge gained will be shared among the industry, in order to facilitate and accelerate the renovation of homes.
