





Workplan and Terms of Reference revision (work in progress)

Inputs taken into account:

- Previous terms of reference
- · IWG Survey carried out in 2018
- · Proposals from participants













- Working accordingly to the members' real needs (expertise, time available).
- Three web-meetings per year plus possible sub-working groups on specific topics.
- Set up the conditions for the creation of a strong network of reliable experts.
- Set up the conditions for the duration of the IWG after 2021 and for a smooth handover after the present coordination.



LEAP4SME objectives:

- Exchange of developments, information and experience on national policies.
- Strengthen the cooperation between WG members.
- Dissemination of joint projects and initiation of joint activities/projects.



Several EnR National Energy Agencies involved + an experienced Brussels-based Communication firm

- Mapping and understanding the complex context of national and local support to SMEs.
- Mobilising private stakeholders, informing them of existing opportunities and involving them in the policy related actions during the entire project; within this context, setting the conditions for a future smooth dialogue with policymakers.
- Proposing effective and realistic solutions to policy makers and policy implementers in terms of policy schemes, cross-cutting policy solutions embracing both energy and non-energy benefits, policy recommendations.
- Contributing, through LEAP4SME research, analysis, and stakeholder involvement, to the current debate on the assessment of a new definition for small and medium-sized enterprises for the purposes of EED Article 8.


