- Survey carried out in October-November 2018
- 12 respondents to the survey
 - Ademe, Adene, CRES, dena, Enova, IDAE, Motiva, My Energy, RVO, SEDA, Swedish Energy Agency, Swiss Energy
- 11 committed to continue, all 11 already members of the WG Industry

Topics/aspects of industry to be addressed and discussed


- Benchmarking: energy efficiency bm, bm tools in MS, data collection, software for bm
- Successful ee measures and programmes; implementation and costs
- Tools to support new topics (circular economy, resource efficiency)
- SME support: marketing instruments for motivation and influencing SMEs to calculate measures (efficiency + monetary savings)
- Sustainable sources and technology; supply sustainable products and reusable heat, carbon, residual materials
- Capture and storage of CO₂ as accelerator of emission reductions


Topics/aspects of industry to be addressed and discussed
