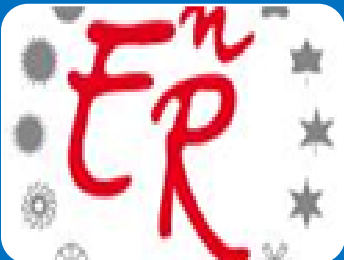

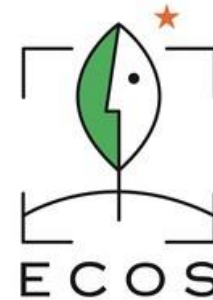

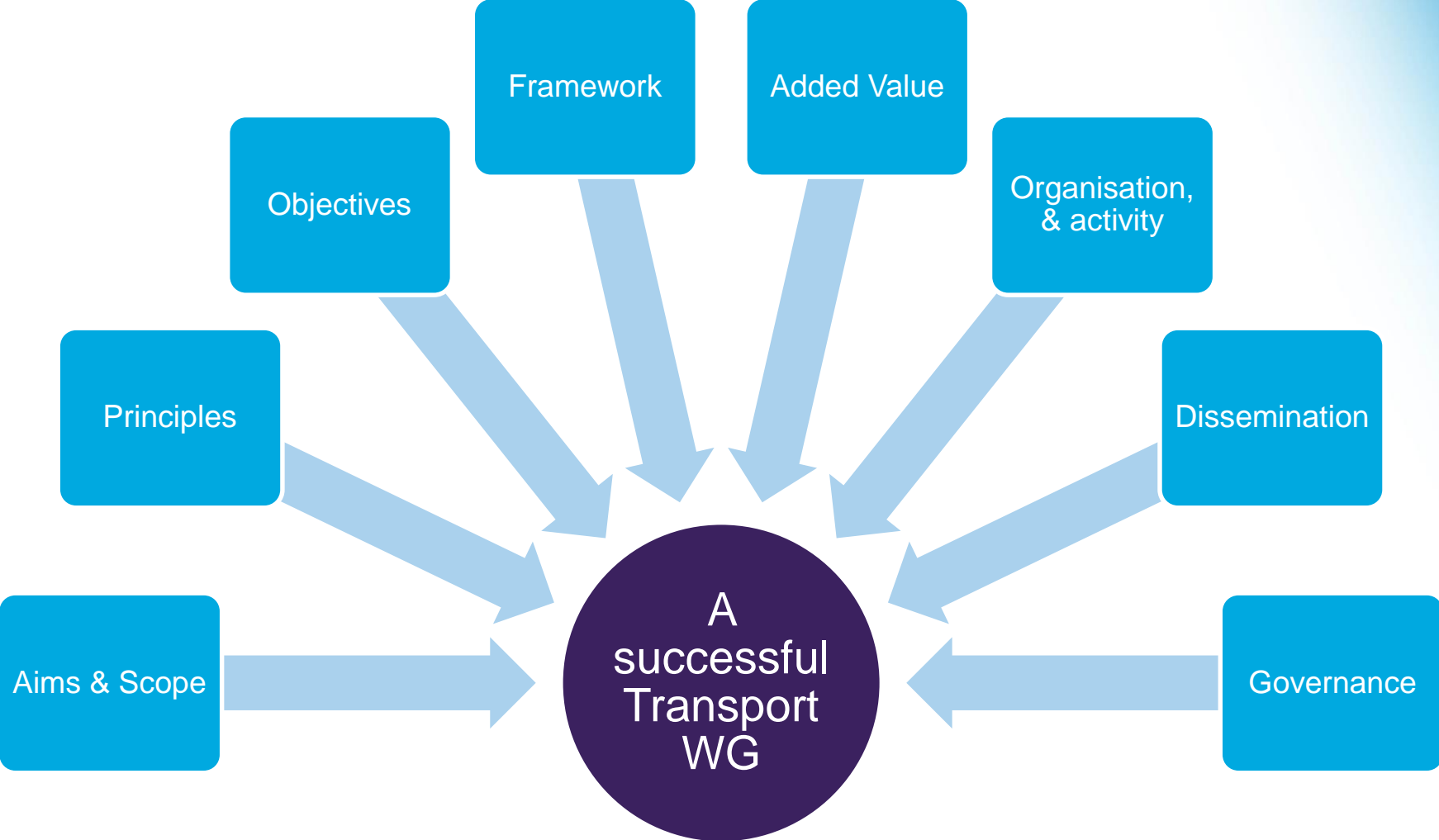


Mixed reaction

Transport WG Terms of Reference Review

Aims/Scope - “Accelerating the shift to sustainable and smart mobility”

- A leading forum for communication and cooperation
- Covering transport of people or goods (freight)
- GHG emissions and air pollution

Objectives

- Information exchange on policies and initiatives of participating agencies/countries
- New joint projects, including projects warranting European funding
- Production and dissemination of information on topics discussed, within WG and in connection EnR Presidency
- Expand WG participation beyond the “Usual Suspects”

Principles

- Provide added value to members
- Share expertise and findings from wider network
- Provide combined expertise of EnR to European Commission
- Not a lobby group but trusted influencer and partner
