## Accommodation – Good Hotel London

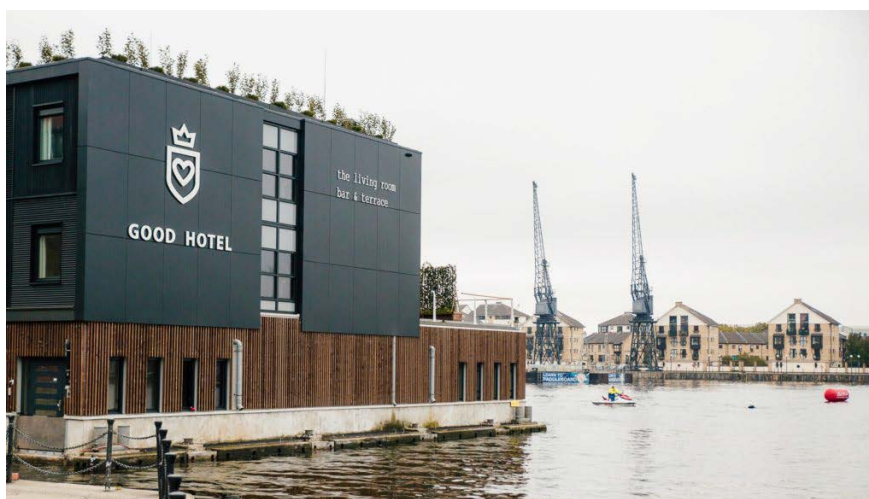

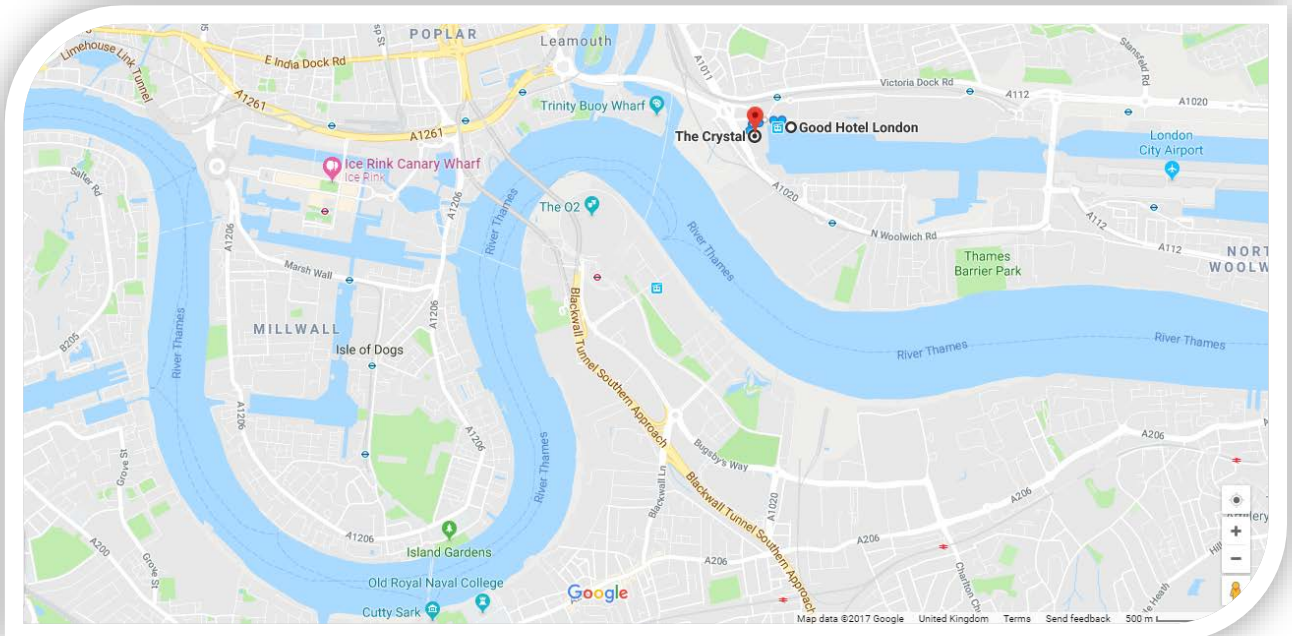

## **Getting around with public transport (Tube, DLR, Overground, bus)**

The cheapest way to get around London by public transport is using an Oyster smart card. You can get an Oyster card for a £5 deposit at all Tube (underground), London Overground and TfL Rail stations, City Airport DLR station and at Visitors Centres (e.g. at Heathrow Airport and Gatwick Airport). You will need to upload money onto the Oyster card. £10 should be sufficient for four journeys within central London (zone 1-2).

### **How to use a contactless debit/credit card or Oyster card on Tube, DLR and Overground:**

- Touch your contactless or Oyster card on a yellow card reader to start a journey. A fare will be deducted.
- At the end of your journey, touch out with the same card on a yellow card reader - doing this means you'll be charged the correct fare.

### **How to use a contactless debit/credit card or Oyster card on the bus:**

- Just touch your contactless or Oyster card on a yellow card reader at the start of your journey. Don't touch out when you get off!
- If you make another bus or tram journey within an hour of touching in on a bus or tram, your second journey will be free.

## **Directions from London City Airport**

### **DLR (Docklands Light Railway)**

The DLR runs every 5-10 minutes from London City Airport towards the city. To get to the hotel, take the DLR line towards *Bank*. Change at the stop *Canning Town* and take a DLR line towards *Beckton*. The stop for the hotel is "Royal Victoria". The hotel is a 200-meter walk away, by the waterside. The journey will take about 15 minutes.

A single journey will cost £1.70 (peak times: Monday to Friday from 06:30 to 09:30 and from 16:00 to 19:00) and £1.50 (off-peak times) if you pay using a contactless credit/debit card or an Oyster smart card. You can buy a paper ticket at the machine which will cost £4.90.

### **Bus**

From London City airport *bus stand "J"* take bus *474* towards *Canning Town* and get off at the stop *Charrington Steps*. The bus departs every 10 minutes and takes about 7 minutes. From the stop it's just a short 5-minute walk to the hotel.

A bus journey costs £ 1.50. You can pay using a contactless credit/debit card or an Oyster card. You can't pay with cash.

### **Taxi**

A taxi from London City Airport to the Good Hotel takes about 12 minutes and costs approximately £15.

## **Directions from London Heathrow Airport**

### **Public transport**

From Heathrow Airport you can take the Heathrow Express train to *Paddington* station which takes 15 minutes and a single ticket costs between £22 and £25 (return ticket is £37). You can buy a ticket in the airport or at Heathrow Airport station as well as on the train (the latter only by debit/credit card).

From *Paddington* station, take the Bakerloo Tube line (*southbound* towards *Elephant & Castle*) and change at *Baker Street* onto the Jubilee line (*eastbound* towards *Stratford*). Change then at the stop *Canning Town* and take a DLR line towards *Beckton*. The stop for the hotel is "Royal Victoria". A single journey is £3.30 (peak times: Monday to Friday from 06:30 to 09:30 and from 16:00 to 19:00) and £2.80 (off-peak times) if you pay using a contactless credit/debit card or an Oyster smart card (see above for instructions).

## **Taxi**

A taxi from London Heathrow Airport to the Good Hotel takes about 90 minutes and costs approximately £100.

## **Directions from London Gatwick Airport**

### **Public transport**

From Gatwick Airport take a train to London Bridge station which takes 30-50 minutes (30-minute trains leave at .03 and .33 past the hour) and a single ticket costs around £11 (return ticket is £12). You can buy a ticket at Gatwick Airport station.

From *London Bridge*, take the Jubilee line (*eastbound* towards *Stratford*) to the stop *Canning Town* and take a DLR line towards *Beckton*. The stop for the hotel is "Royal Victoria". A single journey costs £3.30 (peak times: Monday to Friday from 06:30 to 09:30 and from 16:00 to 19:00) and £2.80 (off-peak times) if you pay using a contactless credit/debit card or an Oyster smart card (see above for instructions).

## **Taxi**

A taxi from London Gatwick Airport to the Good Hotel takes about 90 minutes and costs approximately £130.

## **Directions from London Stansted Airport**

### **Public transport**

From Stansted Airport take the Stansted Express train (<https://www.stanstedexpress.com/>) to *Liverpool Street* station which takes 50 minutes and a single ticket costs between £10 and £16, depending on when you book (return ticket is £17-£28). You can buy a ticket at Stansted Airport station or in advance making use of cheaper advance tickets and print the ticket at home.

From *Liverpool Street*, take the Central line (*eastbound* towards *Epping/Hainault*) to the stop *Stratford* and change to the Jubilee line (*westbound* towards *Stanmore*). Get off at the stop *Canning Town* and take a DLR line towards *Beckton*. The stop for the hotel is "Royal Victoria". A single journey is £3.30 (peak times: Monday to Friday from 06:30 to 09:30 and from 16:00 to 19:00) and £2.80 (off-peak times) if you pay using a contactless credit/debit card or an Oyster smart card (see above for instructions).

## **Taxi**

A taxi from London Stansted Airport to the Good Hotel takes about 50 minutes and costs approximately £120.

## **Directions from St. Pancras International Station (Eurostar terminal)**

### **Public transport**

From *St. Pancras* station take the Tube's Circle line (towards *Liverpool Street*) and change at *Tower Hill*. Take a DLR line from Tower Gateway DLR station towards *Beckton*. The stop for the hotel is "Royal Victoria". A single journey costs £3.30 (peak times: Monday to Friday from 06:30 to 09:30 and from 16:00 to 19:00) and £2.80 (off-peak times) if you pay using a contactless credit/debit card or an Oyster smart card (see above for instructions).

## Taxi

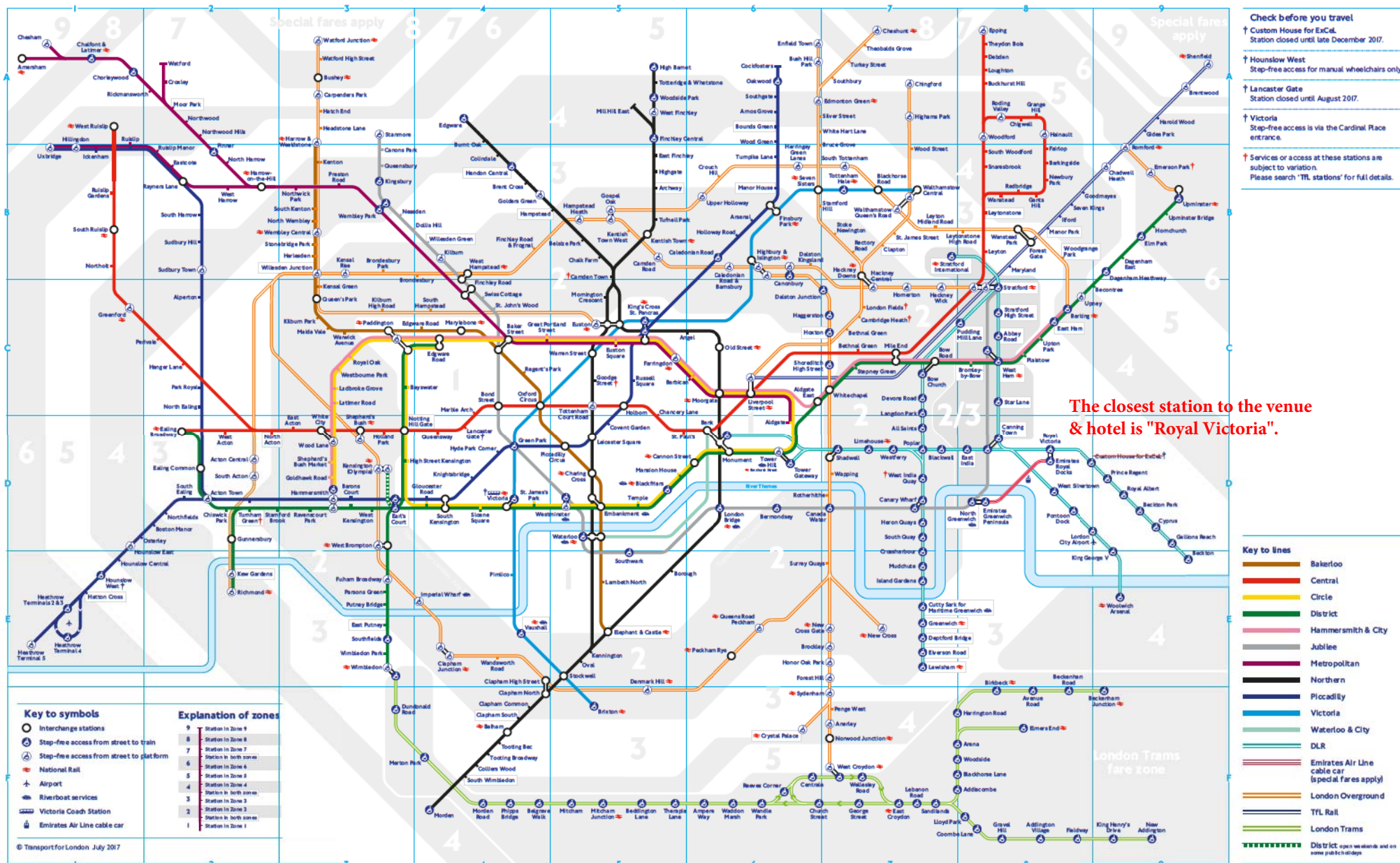
A taxi from St. Pancras station to the Good Hotel takes about 50 minutes and costs approximately £50.
